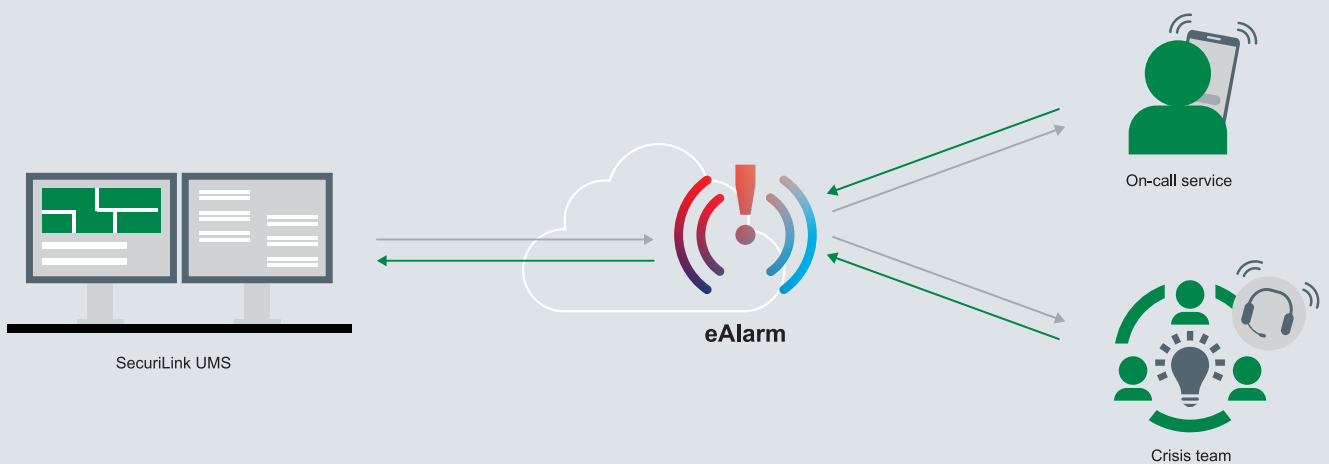

- Live feed with the entire alarm history of the user
